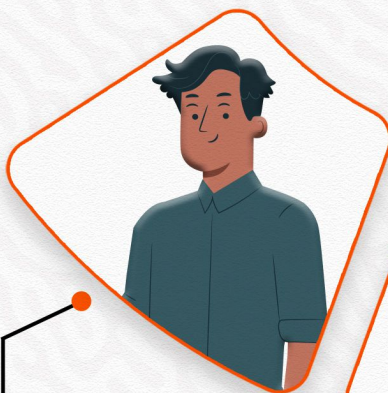


WE ARE INCLUSIVE DIVERSE YOUTH-FRIENDLY

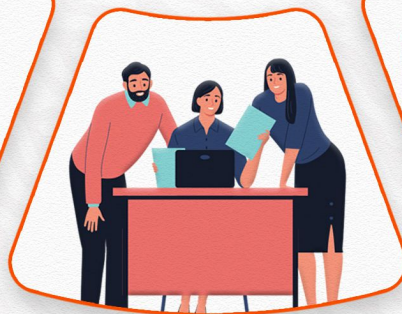
Did you know that The Family Planning Association of Sri Lanka (FPASL) was actually founded in 1953? For the last 7 decades, we have strived to ensure that ALL Sri Lankans have access to sexual health delivery, and understand their reproductive rights.

Last year, we took another look at our governance structures, as ensuring good governance was our priority. The FPA has a governing board, and a team of dedicated staff and volunteers who all work together to further Sri Lanka's sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR) goals.

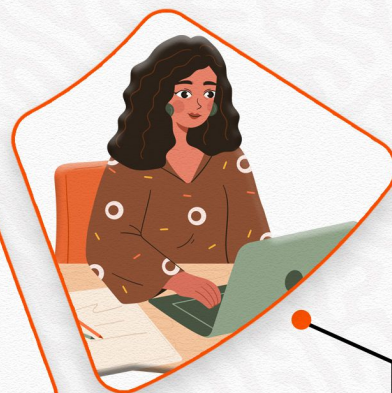
What did we do?



We hired an independent external consultant to review our governance practices and present recommendations for reform



A reform committee debated and voted on these reforms



FPA has now implemented these reforms in hopes of improving our health delivery services

What did we reform?



We will appoint **“patrons”** who will be ambassadors of our organisation and vision



The **“National Council”** was renamed **“the Board of Directors”**



Within the Board, 5 representatives are **young mid-career professionals**, and 4 are **senior professionals**



3 members shall be appointed from outside the membership in order to ensure that the members of the Board have requisite expertise, skills and competency from the fields of corporate, sexual health medical practitioners, marketing, finance, management, legal and advocacy



More than **50% of our Board** is female



Our technical advisory committees will have only up to **7 members**

What did we change?

We will be more attuned to the changing SRHR needs of today's youth



Female changemakers get a seat at the table and are at the forefront of change

The FPA will no longer be known as just a family planning organisation, but one that advocates for SRHR needs of the 21st century
